Good Samaritan Rescue Mission - Bunk Bed Project

Project Description

1. Describe the project. What was done, when, and where did the project activities take place?

- The project activity took place at the Good Samaritan Rescue Mission located at 210 S. Alameda @ Kinney, Corpus Christi, TX, 78401. On November 7, 2019, The Rotary Club of West Corpus Christi installed four military grade bunk beds for the Good Samaritan Rescue Mission.

2. How many people benefited from this project?

- The four bunk beds accommodates 8 individuals. According to the Executive Director, Carole Murphrey, there are about 3,000 homeless people in Nueces County. These bunk beds will serve more than just 8 individuals in time. With a rotating roster of guest, these four bunk beds will have a much greater impact on our community.

3. Who were the beneficiaries, how were they impacted by this project, and what humanitarian need was met?

- The beneficiaries were the homeless individuals at the Good Samaritan Rescue Mission. Winter was approaching and the shelter had been at capacity and they had recently turned away new check-ins.
- The humanitarian need that was met was providing a safe environment for individuals that needed shelter, employment and medical assistance. Additional beds increased the shelter's capacity, allowing for more individuals to benefit from the services provided by the Good Samaritan Rescue Mission . This project will help improve the health, well-being and alleviate poverty for the individuals that are served by this organization.

- Seven Rotarians participated in this project

- Our Club Members met with the Executive Director and toured the facility to assess the shelter's needs. They ordered the military-grade bunk beds and mattresses.
