Camp Freedom Juvenile Diabetes Project

Project Description

1. Describe the project. What was done, when, and where did the project activities take place?

Camp Freedom is a residential/day camp for children who have diabetes. Throughout their stay, campers are taught how to manage their diabetes along with enjoying a fun-filled weekend of swimming, educational activities, games, arts and crafts. Healthcare professionals, educators and volunteers provide supervision throughout the camp program under the guidance of local Pediatric Endocrinologists.
