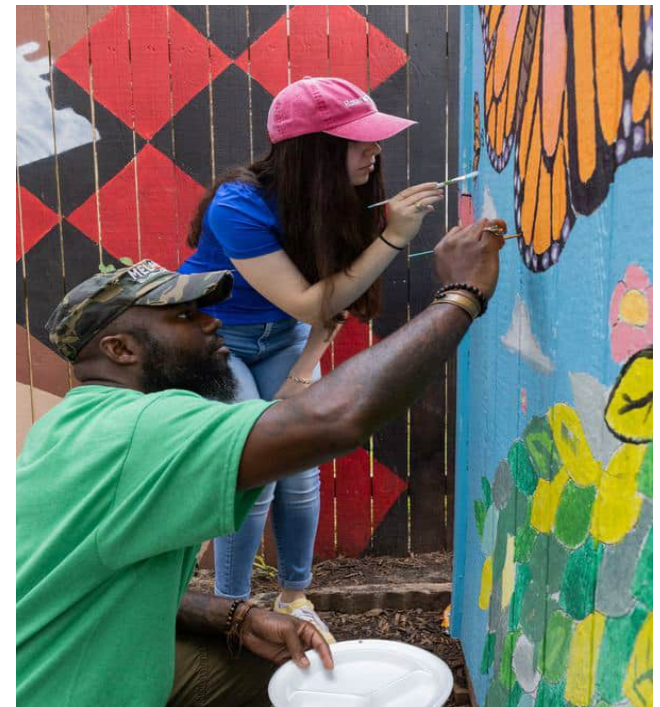

First, is it the **TRUTH**?

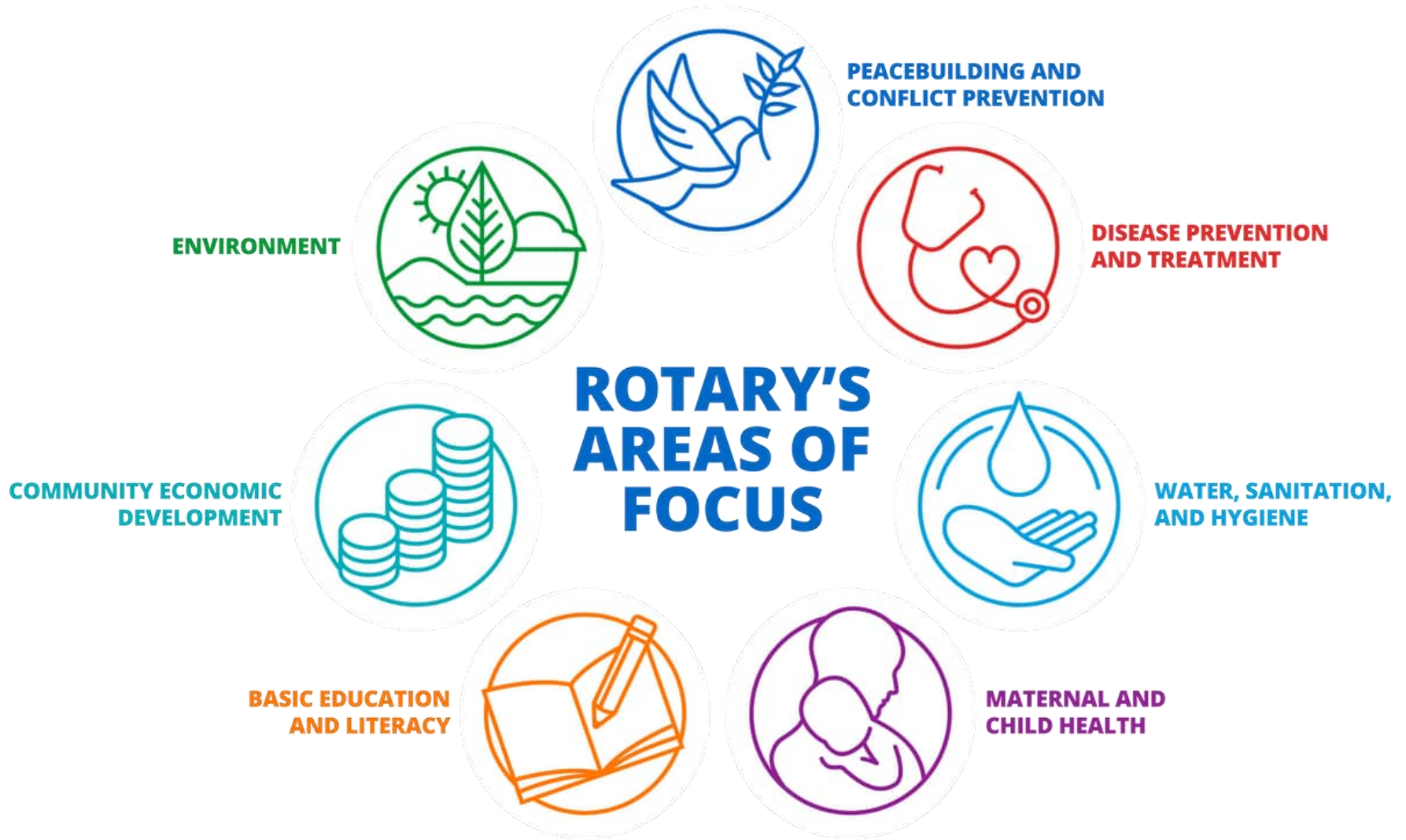
Second, is it **FAIR** to all concerned?
