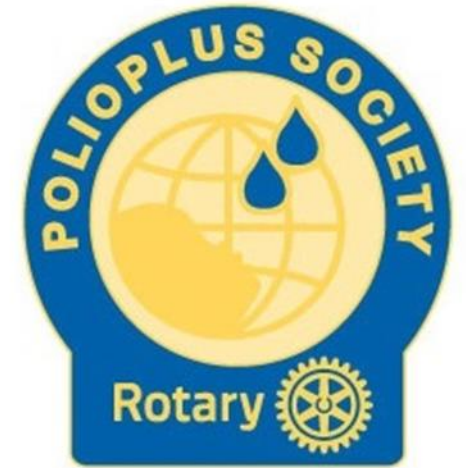


# What is the PolioPlus Society?



The PolioPlus Society, or PPS, is a group of individuals who are passionate about Rotary's #1 Priority...the elimination of the poliovirus from the face of the earth

The PolioPlus Society operates much like the Paul Harris Society, whereby a Rotarian makes a commitment to donate \$1,000 per year or more to The Rotary Foundation. EXCEPT the PolioPlus Society requires you to donate only a minimum of \$100 per year and to continue to do so annually until the World Health Organization (WHO) declares the world free of the poliovirus.

PolioPlus Society members will receive a special pin depicting a child receiving the two precious drops, and "End Polio Now" wristband to wear until polio is eliminated from the planet, and a PolioPlus Certificate proclaiming our membership in this unique Society. Plus the knowledge that you are doing good in the world and are in this fight to the end.

## Joining the Society is a Three-Step Process.

**Step 2:** To make your tax-deductible donation go to [myrotary.org/donate](http://myrotary.org/donate), sign in and click on “Polio Fund”. You can choose a one-time donation of \$100 or more, or a recurring donation in the amount and frequency of your choice (We suggest \$10/month as the “easy way” to become a PolioPlus Society member.) Of course, you can also write a check payable To “The Rotary Foundation”, with PolioPlus in the memo section, and give it to your club’s Foundation Chair.

Your contribution also qualifies for Paul Harris Fellow Recognition Points and will be matched 2 to 1 by the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation.

**Step 3:** Notify your District PolioPlus chair at the address above of your donation and method used (recurring credit card, one-time credit card, or by check)
