Qualification Requirements:

1. Club is in good standing with IRS
2. Rotary International confirms the Rotary Club qualifies for the RI 2020-2021 Rotary Citation.
3. Club Officers for the upcoming Rotary year (2020-2021) are reported to Club and District websites (www.rotary5930.org) & My Rotary (www.rotary.org or data@rotary.org) no later than the end of June 2020.
4. Club Officers for the upcoming Rotary year (2021-2022) are reported to Club and District web sites (www.rotary5930.org) & My Rotary (www.rotary.org or data@rotary.org) no later than the end of January 01, 2021.

Successfully Complete any 9 of the 12 requirements described below:

1. Your Club will host at least one Strategic Planning meeting each year at which you ask: "What should our club be like in 5 years and what steps should we take to achieve this?"
2. Qualify as an Ignite Premier Club in the **District 5930 2020-2021 IGNITE** program or implement and document some membership recruitment & retention program.
3. Start a new Rotary Club or Rotaract Club following the Rotary Club Models worksheet.
4. Participate as a sponsor, associate sponsor or contributor in a Rotary project providing service in one of Rotary International's "Seven Areas of Focus" in another country (minimum financial participation should be equivalent to \$10 per club member).
5. Participate in at least **4** of the following District 5930 **Youth Services Programs** by sponsoring or co-sponsoring a:
 - a. Four Way Test Speech Contest participant
 - b. RYLA participant
 - c. EarlyAct FirstKnight or Early Act
 - d. Rotaract Club
 - e. Interact Club
 - f. Youth Exchange participant
 - g. Adoption Awareness Picnic
 - h. Global Grant Scholar
 - i. District Grant Costa Rica or Veteran's Scholar
6. **Club President Elect attended Lone Star PETS 2020 or a PETS Alliance Multi-District PETS.**

7. At least 15% (10 members max) of club members attend 2020 District Assembly to train Club leadership and introduce interested Rotarians to the RI Strategic Plan including Becoming and Maintaining a Vibrant Club, Rotary Leadership development, Club Administration, importance of our Rotary's Public Image and the Rotary Brand, Supporting our Rotary Foundation and how it will support your Club Service projects, to be held on ~~Saturday, May 16, 2020 at Texas A & M-Kingsville~~. Virtually in June 2020. Attendance must be at the live Zoom meetings where attendance is taken. There is no way to track watching the videos.
8. At least 15% (10 members max) of club members attend the Rotary District 4:1- Exciting Rotary Leadership Institute training (RLI), Enhancing Rotary's Public Image in your community, Membership Matters and Your Rotary Foundation in Action ~~to be held on October 03, 2020~~. Virtually in September/October 2020. Attendance must be at the live Zoom meetings where attendance is taken. There is no way to track watching the videos.
9. At least 15% (10 members max) of club members attend your 2021 District Conference for Rotarians, Family and Youth on April 30 to May 02, 2021 at the Harlingen Convention Center or virtually in May 2021. Attendance must be at the live Zoom meetings where attendance is taken. There is no way to track watching the videos.
10. At least 15% of Club Membership (as of May 31, 2021) is registered (login & password) on My Rotary (www.rotary.org) and Club Runner (www.rotary5930.org).
11. Participate in a Polio Day event – virtual or in-person. Show documentation.
12. Participate in a Rotary Peace event – virtual or in-person. Show documentation.

Exemplary Clubs will receive a certificate and trophy, with special recognition given at a District Event in the Fall of 2021, as well as other recognition on the District Website and Facebook page.
