Mid Valley Christian School Running Track

Project Description

1. Describe the project. What was done, when, and where did the project activities take place?

Our district grant project was to construct an asphalt running track at a local non-profit school in our community called Mid Valley Christian School. The construction started May 6th 2020.

2. How many people benefited from this project? This school has been serving our community for over 45 years, and we foresee that several thousand students will benefit from this track for many years to come.

3. Who were the beneficiaries, how were they impacted by this project, and what humanitarian need was met? The beneficiaries that benefited from this project directly are the students that will be able to run on pavement versus dirt, thus helping them stay in physical shape. Before, this track had terrain that was very uneven and would get very muddy during the rainy season. Now, students will be able to continue their cardio workouts without fear of spraining an ankle or getting muddy.

4. How many Rotarians participated in this project? We had a grant committee and many volunteers ready to help during the construction of this track. However, the mandatory government quarantine due to the COVID-19 did not allow any of us to attend. I was, however, able to be there to document the process in pictures.

5. What did they do? Please give at least two examples, not including financial support provided to the project. There are currently no examples of how we were able to help due to quarantine.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?

The cooperating organization was the school itself. We received several quotes and chose the less expensive route. Our club donated \$3,700, the district contributed another \$3,700, and the school paid for the remainder. They had several successful fundraisers throughout the year and were able to pay with no trouble.
