

# Individual Project Report

## 6th Annual FEED, FIT, & READ

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### Project Description

1. Describe the project. What was done, when, and where did the project activities take place?

Caritas Feed Fit and Read took place on November 11, 2017 at the Parish Hall of Our Lady of Perpetual Help located at 2209 Kendlewood Ave. in McAllen, TX. It took place from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Caritas Service Group of OLPH along with the area Rotary Clubs participated in feeding, measuring sizes for and distributing shoes and donating books to needy children of the McAllen, TX area. McAllen Evening Rotary Club, McAllen North Rotary Club, McAllen South Rotary Club, McAllen Founders Rotary Club, Edinburg Rotary Club, and Mission Rotary Club participated in the event. Also, Interact Clubs from McAllen Memorial and McAllen High Schools and the National Honor Society from Nikki Rowe and Valley View High Schools played an active role in the event.

2. How many people benefited from this project?

Approximately 1200 children benefited from this project.

3. Who were the beneficiaries, how were they impacted by this project, and what humanitarian need was met?

The beneficiaries were children from the McAllen area including students identified at McAllen ISD and Edinburg CISD. The children now understand that there are people in the community who understand their needs and are willing to give of their time and resources to provide for that need. The basic need of providing clothing for needy children, specifically shoes, was met.

4. How many Rotarians participated in this project?

Approximately 38 Rotarians participated in the project.

5. What did they do? Please give at least two examples, not including financial support provided to the project.

The Rotarians provided food and coordinated the cooking and distribution of the food. They coordinated the book contributions and distribution of books to the children. They assisted in the sizing and distribution of the shoes to the children. They also participated in face-painting for the children.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?

Caritas Service Group of Our Lady of Perpetual Help in McAllen, TX oversaw and coordinated the overall fundraising for the project, ordered and maintained the shoe inventory, coordinated with the participating school districts to identify the needy children, coordinated volunteer services, and ran the distribution, including the check-in, sizing and inventory distribution.

HEB provided gift cards to purchase food to feed the children.
