Project Description

1. Describe the project. What was done, when, and where did the project activities take place?

The City of Harlingen, along with Keep Harlingen Beautiful teamed up with Sunburst Rotary to purchase and install 21 park benches. 18 benches were installed along the walking path in Pendleton Park. The other 3 were placed around a playground in Vestal Park. The benches were installed beginning in January, and finishing in early March.
