Project Description

- 1. Describe the project. What was done, when, and where did the project activities take place? This project was to improve and enhance the Con Mis Manos Resource Center facility in Matamoros, Mexico. Con Mis Manos assists the deaf and their families through education, counseling, vocational training, and evangelism. At present, this facility is lacking many basic items that will help give the occupants and students much motivation to succeed in their lives. The majority of the items that are direly desired were purchased locally in the U.S. then transferred across into Matamoros, Mexico. The items were purchased between August 2016 and April 2017 with most being purchased by October 2016.

 The people that benefitted from this project are the students and parents of the students that attend Con Mis Manos as well as the residents that stay there full-time. At this time, there are 42 students and 15 residents (full-time).
- 3. Who were the beneficiaries, how were they impacted by this project, and what humanitarian need was met? All the students and full-time residents now have basic needs such as refrigerated food, bedding, and cooking which were greatly improved by the purchase of the following: washer, refrigerator, oven, water dispenser, air conditioning, bedding, tables, and chairs.

 There were Rotarians from the U.S. and Mexico who participated in this project. Five From Brownsville-Sunrise and two from the Brownsville Club. Four Rotarians from the Matamoros Professional Club participated as well.

This included help with the tax-exempt status at each store, moving the items through the store, and loading them into the vehicles.
